

Car Maintenance



Once you purchase a car, you MUST maintain it!
Here are a few tips to keep your car running longer:

- When refueling your car, be absolutely **SURE** that you are putting in the proper fuel. Putting Diesel fuel in a gas engine will cost you money. Putting unleaded gas in a Diesel engine will cost you lots of money!
- Change your oil every 3,000 miles
- Check the air pressure in your tires regularly (at least once a month)
- Check your oil level when you fill your car with gas. Add oil as needed.
- Make sure your car's anti-freeze/coolant is in good condition.
- Make sure that the windshield wipers are in good condition

For every car owner, a good honest mechanic is **ESSENTIAL**. You do not want to pay for repairs that you don't need. When you take your car to the mechanic, you do not want to have to lose time going back if it is not fixed correctly.
